If you want to become a Young Inspector, you will need to voluntarily attend a 2-day training session in the October half term

- Lead real inspections of real services in Surrey
- Get paid for their time
- Meet new people and make friends
- A portfolio and certificate of their achievement for their CV
- Build confidence and give constructive feedback
